Uniform

Our school takes pride in its appearance and presentation within the community. A consistent dress code helps students reflect this pride and promotes a positive image. The Student Dress Code is supported by our school community as it contributes to a safe and respectful teaching and learning environment by:

- Enabling easy identification of students both on campus and in public
- Reducing distractions from competition in dress and fashion
- Fostering a sense of belonging
- Encouraging mutual respect by minimising visible socio-economic differences

Students are expected to wear the correct uniform at all times, representing themselves, their school, their family, and their community. We encourage all students to wear the uniform with pride, and we ask all adults to support this expectation.

Uniform Details:

Dress: Formal white and blue striped dress

Skorts: Navy school skort

Shorts: Navy school shorts

Long/track suit pants: Navy pants

Shirt: School blue marl polo shirt or formal white and blue shirt

Tights/Leggings: black or navy (these are to be worn underneath the dress, shorts or skorts, not with just the school polo shirt)

Socks: White or Black

Shoes: Plain black closed in or sport shoes (predominately white or black)

Hat: Prep: Red school hat
Years 1-6: Navy school hat

Jumper: Fleecy jacket with zipper or school rugby jersey

Optional:

- Year 5 & 6 Interschool Sports shirt
- Year 6 senior shirts
- FTPSS Navy School Bag
- Chair Bags (year 2-6)
- Music Shirt
- Music Folder

Music Uniform

All students in the Choir, Band and Strings wear a FTPSS Music shirt, black pants, black socks and black shoes.

Uniform Shop

Our uniform shop has a full range of new uniforms all year round. The uniform shop is located in the Tuckshop and is open Tuesday and Thursday afternoon 2.15pm to 3.00pm and items can be ordered through Flexischools. There is also a range of quality second hand uniforms available.

Winter

Students are encouraged to wear approved uniform items for layering in the morning and removing as temperatures rise throughout the day. Coloured jackets or jumpers are not permitted.

Sun Safety

Our school enforces a No Hat No Play rule. All students are to wear the school hat. All students must wear sun safe shirts (e.g. a rashie) during outdoor water activities. It is recommended that sunscreen is applied.

Jewellery

A watch and a pair of sleepers or studs (in ears only) are the only approved accessories. No other necklaces, bracelets, anklets, or rings are permitted unless for religious or cultural reasons. Medical bracelets and necklaces are allowed.

Hair

Hair is to be neat and tidy. Only natural hair colour and minimal hair accessories in school colours are approved.

Cosmetics

No make-up. Clear nail polish only.

Free Dress days

Free dress day clothing must be sun safe – covered shoulders and midriff. There should be no inappropriate logos, images, slogans or wording. Footwear must be covered in – no thongs or sandals.

Lost Property

All personal items should be clearly labelled with your child's name. Labelled items will be returned to the child's class. Unlabelled items can be found in the lost property trolley outside the office.

Uniform Reminders

Regular reminders about the uniform policy will be provided to students. Those wearing inappropriate items (e.g., jewellery) will be asked to remove them. In cases of financial hardship, the Principal may discreetly provide a uniform to students in need.
