• Year 4 – 6 students will have access to their online OneNote via their EQ MIS (Managed Internet Service.) They will require their MIS username and password to access their classroom OneNote.

1) Open the **internet** (If it doesn't work in one browser, try another e.g. Google Chrome, Edge, Firefox.)



2) In the address bar, type in mis.eq.edu.au. (Please note there is no www.)



3) Sign in using your **student MIS username** and Password e.g. your child's MIS username is - owell7 (**not** <u>owell7@eq.edu.au</u>)

*If your child has forgotten their password, you may need to email their class teacher. This is a new skill for Year 4, so please give them a few chances.

4) Click on the waffle, located in the top left hand corner. Then OneNote.



5) Click the **recent** tab, then your child's OneNote e.g. <u>4L</u>. *

** Pinning the app to your task bar allows students to continuously access their classroom OneNote via the app, as opposed to the MIS Gateway. By using the app, they will no longer need to log in, just click on the OneNote app and their classroom OneNote will open.

Trouble Shooting

- The download process (from online to OneNote app) may briefly go into a non-responsive mode. Please be patient, this is normal with large downloads.
- It is optional to download and use the Microsoft OneNote Ipad app and sign in with a **student account**.
