This funding will be used to

- Engage every student in Inquiry focused learning.
- Maintain or increase student achievement in NAPLAN Upper 2 Bands, Reading and Numeracy to 75% or above.
- Increase student achievement in NAPLAN Upper 2 Bands, for Year 5 Writing to 45%.

Our initiatives include

- Delivery of intensive literacy and numeracy intervention to targeted students in P-6, promoting learning progress through flexible approaches (Sharratt and Fullan 2012).
- Increasing student achievement in writing through explicit teaching and formative assessment strategies to track progress, analyse data and provide feedback that informs teaching and learning (Hopkins, Craig & Knight 2015).
- Leading cycle of inquiry by school improvement team to research, trial and recommend practices in teaching of writing at FTPSS.
- Development of a coaching and mentoring model to support FTPSS teachers with implementation of Curiosity & Powerful Learning (Hopkins, Craig & Knight 2015).

Increase literacy & numeracy resources	\$20,000
Additional Speech Pathologist allocation to support early literacy & numeracy intervention	\$10,000
Employing Curiosity & Powerful Learning Coach to lead and support the implementation of CPL, with specific focus on Inquiry teaching and assessment for learning	\$4,500
Release classroom teachers for professional development and to work collaboratively to develop a greater understanding of Inquiry and writing across the curriculum	\$32,198
